

Rescheduling the October 2, 2025 Special General Meeting Date

Recommendation

Due to scheduling conflicts, staff recommends that the Sonoma County Mayors' and Councilmembers' Association Board of Directors approve rescheduling the Special General Meeting originally set for Thursday, October 2, 2025, to Thursday, October 23, 2025.

Background

Per Article 7, Section 1 of the Association's By-laws, the General Membership is required to meet at least five times annually on the second Thursday of February, April, June, August, and October at a time and location designated by the Chairperson, following the City/Town rotation outlined in Article V, Section 4. Modifications to this schedule may be made by a majority vote (5 of 9) of the Board of Directors.

At its May 8, 2025 meeting, the Board approved moving the October General Membership meeting from October 9 to October 2, 2025, to avoid a conflict with the League of California Cities Annual Conference and Expo, scheduled for October 8–10, 2025.

Analysis/Discussion

Subsequent to the May 8 decision, it was brought to the Board's attention that the newly scheduled October 2nd meeting coincides with Yom Kippur, a significant religious observance for many Board and community members. In light of this conflict, a request was made to identify a more suitable date.

Staff consulted with the Town of Windsor, the designated host for the October meeting. After reviewing alternative dates, Windsor recommended rescheduling the meeting to Thursday, October 23, 2025. This revised date avoids religious and professional conflicts and supports broad participation from member jurisdictions.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board approve rescheduling the October Special General Meeting to October 23, 2025, in coordination with the Town of Windsor.
